

## **Appendix A: Welfare gains/losses**

The percentage change in real income associated with a change in trade costs equals the percentage fall in the share of a country's consumption of its own goods raised to a power equal to the elasticity of trade with respect to trade costs (Helpman 2014, 5). Welfare costs, therefore, rise with the import-penetration ratios of states. Because large states typically produce more of what they consume at home, these ratios are relatively low for major trading nations even in the contemporary era. In 2000, for example, the United States had an import penetration ratio of seven percent (Arkolakis, Costinot, and Rodriguez-Clare 2012, 95).

The formula to calculate welfare losses or gains is  $\omega = \hat{\lambda}^{1/\epsilon}$ , where  $\omega$  is the change in real income associated with a foreign shock;  $\hat{\lambda}$  is the change in the share of domestic expenditures on domestic products; and  $\epsilon$  is the elasticity of substitution (how easily a good can be substituted with another product).

We calculate  $\lambda'/\lambda$  where  $\lambda'$  is the share of domestic expenditures of each belligerent in 1913 and  $\lambda$  is the share of domestic expenditures on domestic products in each year of the war (1 - import-penetration ratio of a state). Anderson and van Wincoop report most estimated elasticities are "in the range of 5 to 10" (2004, 716). In their study of trade between 1870 and 2000, Jacks, Meissner, and Novy (2011, 189) use "roughly the midpoint" elasticity of 8. Anderson and van Wincoop also note that higher elasticities are associated with more homogenous goods, so we would expect World War I elasticities to be relatively high. The estimate we use for the results we report in the text is -5. Nevertheless, to be conservative, we use trade elasticities between -3 and -9. We report the associated welfare losses immediately below.

We measure the difference in the gains from trade between 1913 and each year from 1914 to 1918. We then subtract from that the gains from trade in each year from 1914 to 1918. A positive value means that import penetration is higher in the wartime years, implying gains from trade. A negative value indicates the import penetration fell, generating a loss. We use Maddison's GDP data ([sites.google.com/site/econgeodata/maddison-data-on-population-gdp](http://sites.google.com/site/econgeodata/maddison-data-on-population-gdp)).

The welfare costs we estimate are overstated because Arkolakis, Costinot, and Rodriguez-Clare (2012) calculate import penetration using imports over gross output. Gross output always exceeds GDP, because it includes the value of intermediate goods. In 1997, for example, U.S. GDP was about 55 percent of gross output. We use GDP, the value of final goods, here because we don't have data on gross output. This systematically increases values of import penetration and the gains or losses from trade.
