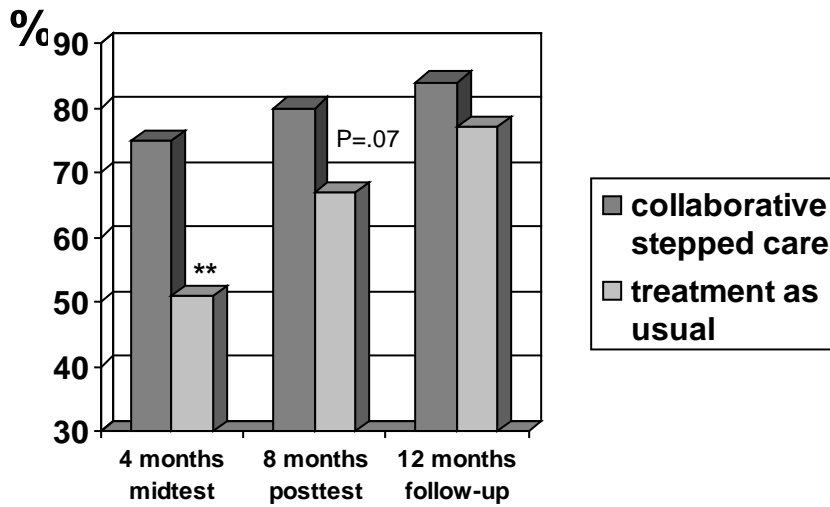
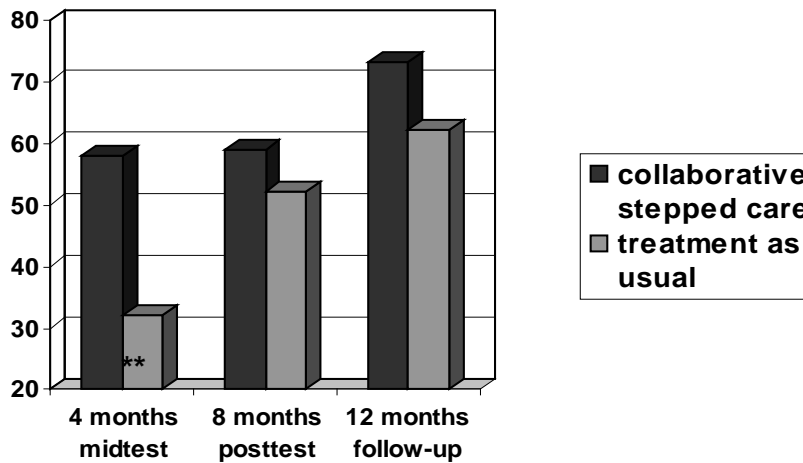

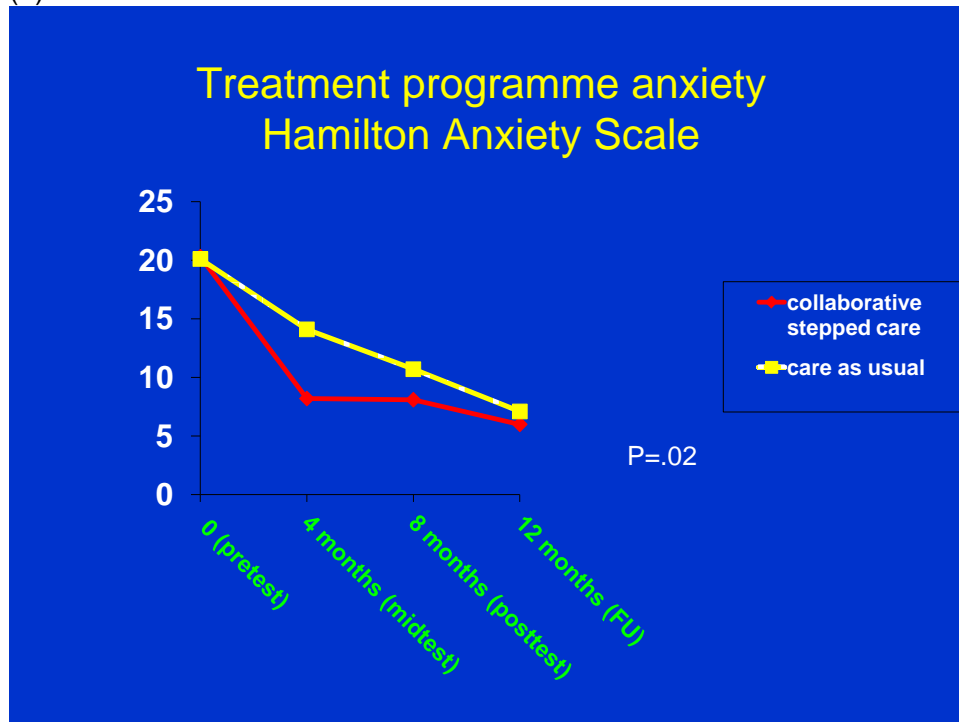
Fig. DS1 Responder rates for collaborative stepped care v. care as usual (intent-to-treat sample).

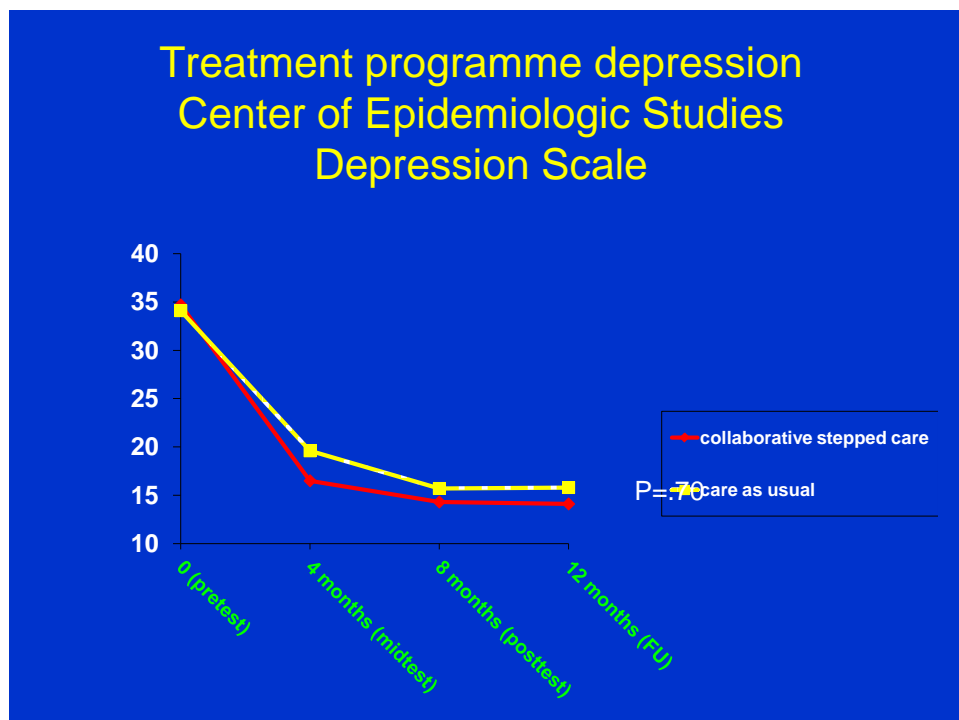
