11 Avoidance distance (AD) of 4 week old male and female calves reared with contact to their mother
12 (*Dam-contact*, n=19) or separated within the first day of life (*Artificial*, N=20). A and B depict AD for
13 the two treatments either tested in the home pen in the group (A) or in an arena (B). C and D show AD
14 of all calves in relation to the number of days of close contact with humans in the first 5 days of life
15 (human contact days, always 5 days for *Artificial*, red circles; 0-4 days for *Dam-contact*, blue circles).
16 Graphs are based on original data.

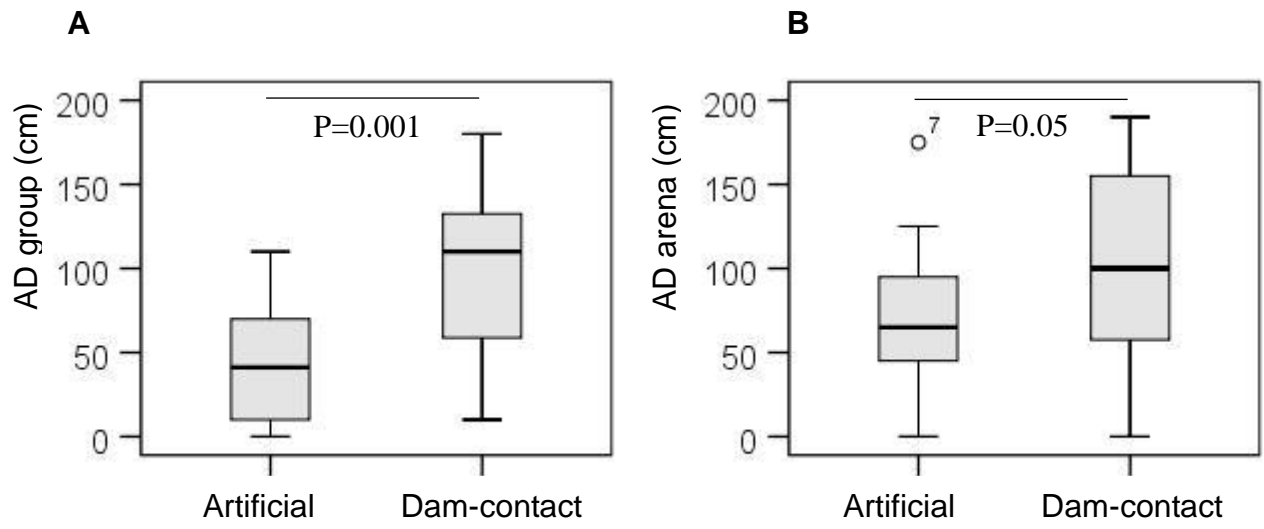

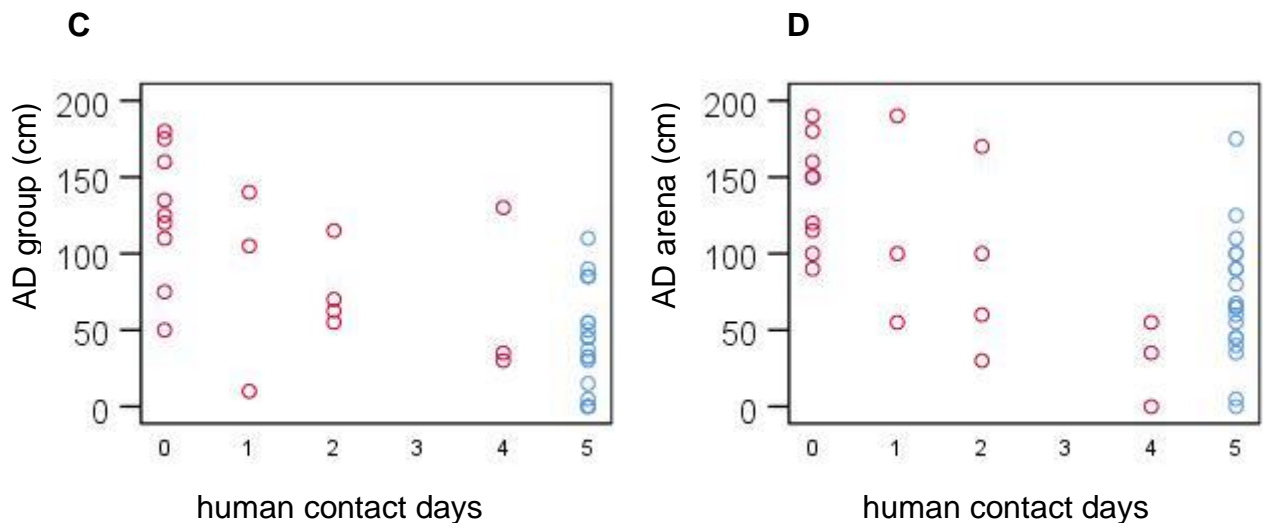
