Morphology of *Pomphorhynchus tereticollis* from the intestine of *Oncorhynchus mykiss* from the River Kennet, England showing; (a) elongated neck (n), pronounced bulb (b) and proboscis (p); (b) rows of hooks lining the proboscis (c) notable stoutness of hook (*) within row 5 or 6 of the proboscis compared with posterior hooks (**) (d) proximal projections (arrows) of hooks located in the posterior region of the proboscis, observed in live specimens.
