

Supplement 3 – Family History of Psychosis in the COPE sample

Specific Family History Diagnoses

Of the 33 individuals reporting family history of psychosis, 28 (84.85%) had a single affected relative; specifically, 8 (28.57%) with SZ; 2 (7.14%) with Schizoaffective Disorder (SAD); 6 (21.43%) with Bipolar Disorder (BPD) with Psychotic Features; 2 (7.14%) with MDD with Psychotic Features; and 10 (35.71%) with Psychotic Disorder Not Otherwise Specified (PD-NOS). Four of the 33 (12.12%) with positive histories reported two first-degree relatives with psychosis; specifically, 2 (50.0%) had one parent with SZ and one with SAD; 1 (25.0%) had a parent with psychotic BPD and a brother with SZ; and 1 (25.0%) had one parent with SAD and one with PD-NOS. One of the 33 (3.03%) had three affected first-degree relatives; specifically, one parent with psychotic BPD and two siblings with SAD.
