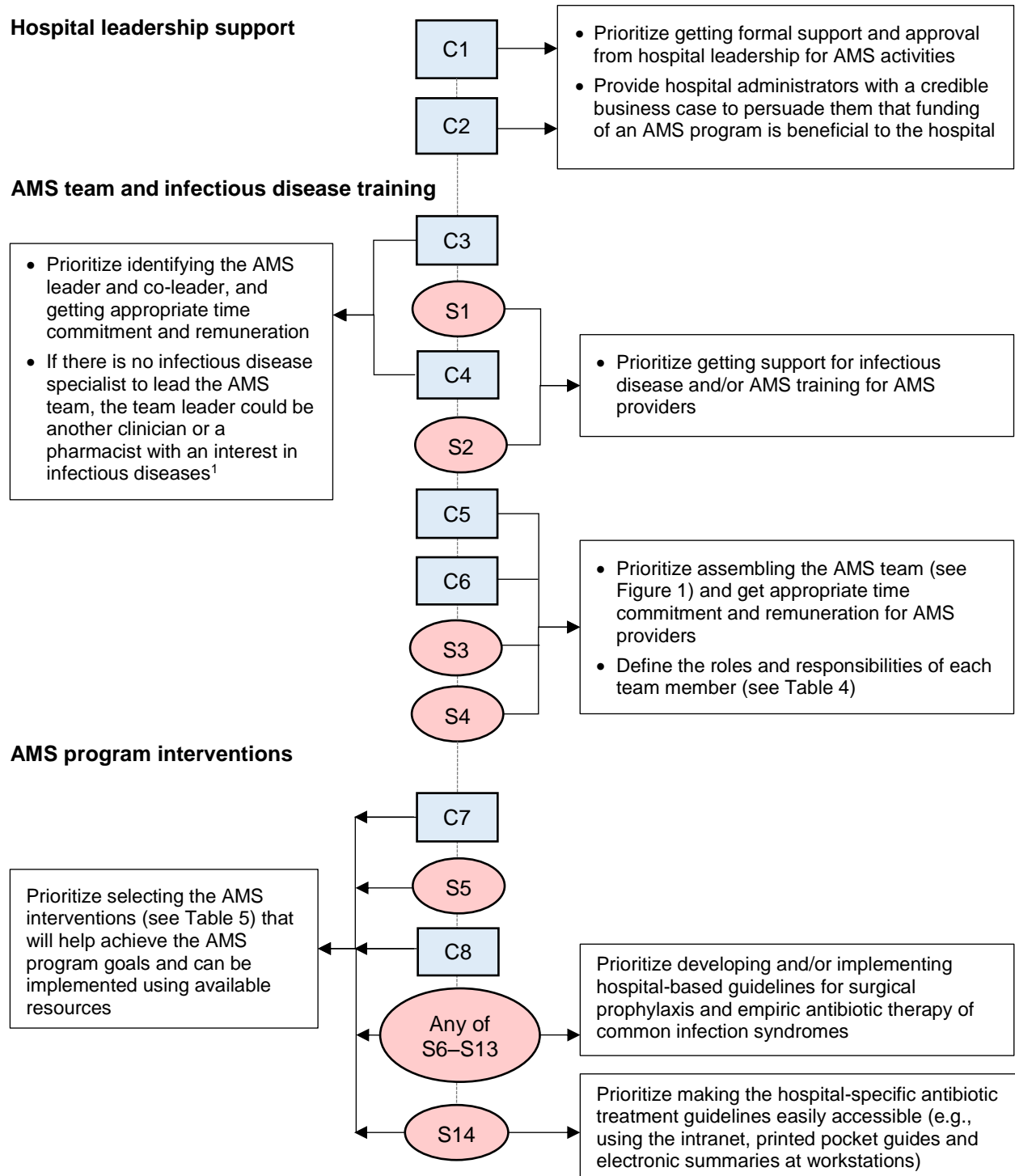


Supplementary Material S2. Flowchart of potential next steps to overcome gaps and challenges in antimicrobial stewardship programs in Asian hospitals

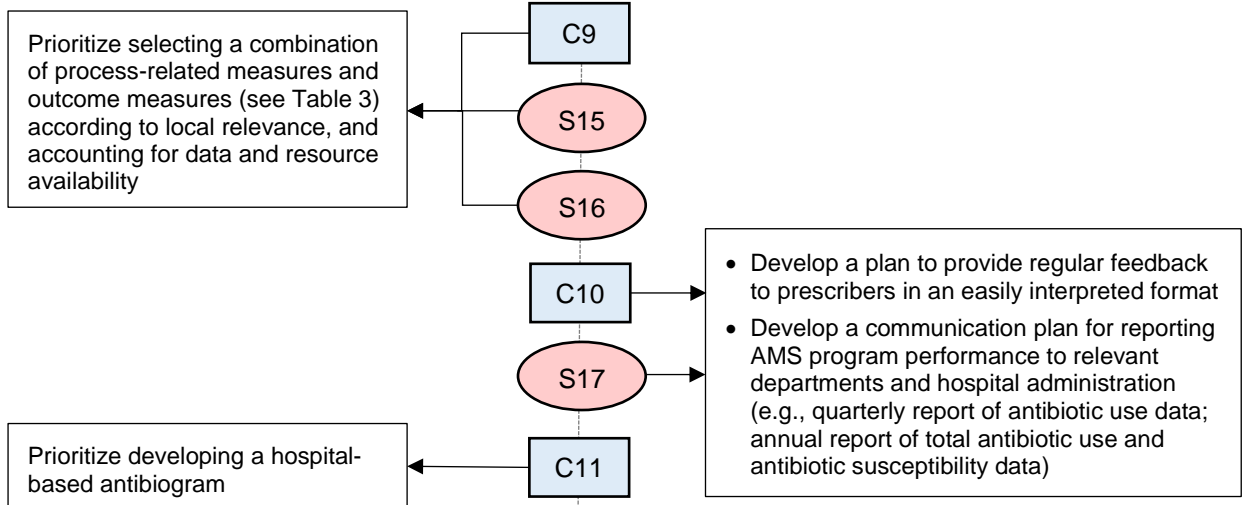

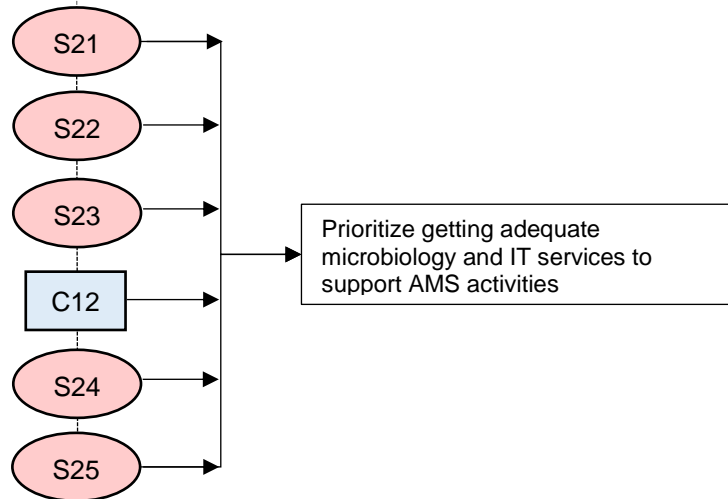

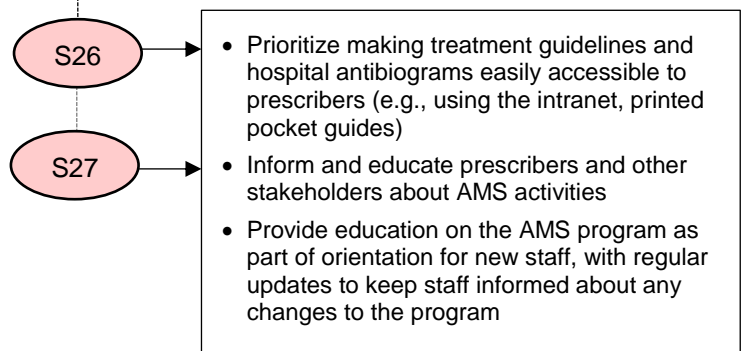
