Column headings in the files denote the following:

TrialItem	the stimulus being judged
Subject	the subject ID
TrialNumber	the order in which that trial took place in that subject's experiment
ViolatesBackness	0 = false, 1 = true
ViolatesNasal	0 = false, 1 = true
ViolatesSibilant	0 = false, 1 = true
Response	whether the subject endorsed the item
Rating	the rating assigned in the ratings task
Training	the counterbalancing condition for training, in Experiments 1, 2 and 4
Phase	whether this was the first or second presentation of the item (relevant only for the binary decision task in Experiment 1)
C_Viols	number of disharmonic consonants
V_Viols	number of disharmonic vowels
