

Supplementary Figure S4 (online only). Incremental cost-effectiveness plane, based on 'NL and B data'. This figure shows the result of 10,000 model simulations (PSA), and the mean value, based on the 'NL and B' data. Costs of a PoCT are set at € 45, and reduction of ACS negative referrals (FPs) is assumed to be 39.5% (cost-neutral as compared to current practice, see figure S2).
