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Dr. Carr is residency trained and board certified in emergency medicine, and completed fellowships in trauma and surgical critical care, as well as in health policy research at the University of Pennsylvania as a part of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation's Clinical Scholar program. Dr. Carr's research focuses on the association between emergency care system design and outcomes for unplanned critical illness including trauma, stroke, and cardiac arrest. He remains clinically active, caring for patients in the Emergency Department. In 2010, Dr. Carr led a national conference to define the research agenda for regionalized emergency care systems and was appointed as Director of the Emergency Care Coordination Center within the Department of Health & Human Services in December of 2013.
